Provincial/National Classes

Before competing in the National Music Festival, competitors must first qualify at a Local Music Festival in the province where they live or study.

After attaining the required standard, they must be recommended by the adjudicator(s) to proceed to the Provincial Level of competition.

The winner in each class at the Provincial Level of competition, if recommended by the adjudicator, is then eligible to compete in the National Music Festival.
